

Dear Citizens.

The Municipality of Lantier wishes to inform you that new procedures will now be in effect regarding the use of the municipal landing, effective May 12, 2025.

These measures are intended to ensure more efficient and responsible management of our facilities, while contributing to the protection of our bodies of water.

Here are the main points to remember:

Schedule:

The landing is accessible every day. You must report to Town Hall with your boat Monday to Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Outside of the opening hours above, you may call 819-217-0377 between 4:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on weekdays, and on Saturdays and Sundays, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. to gain access. Access outside of these hours is prohibited

Mandatory boat washing:

Before launching, boat washing is mandatory to prevent the spread of invasive aquatic species. A visual inspection will be conducted before launching.

Sticker:

To access the dock, you must have a valid municipal sticker. Any user without proper identification may be denied access.

Secure access - Padlock code

When launching, you will be given a code to unlock the gate. This code will be changed daily to maintain site security and ensure access is restricted to authorized users.
